National Pingtung University Regulations for the Establishment of the College of Management Guidance Committee to Promote Business School Accreditation

Passed May 14, 2015, in the 2nd college affairs meeting held in the 2nd semester of the 2014-15 academic year. Passed Jun 4, 2015, in the 9th NPTU administrative meeting. Passed Sep 27, 2017, in the 1st college affairs meeting held in the 1st semester of the 2017-18 academic year. Passed Nov 2, 2017, in the 34th NPTU administrative meeting. Passed Mar 7, 2019, in the 1st college affairs meeting held in the 2nd semester of the 2018-19 academic year.

- Article 1 The College of Management formulated the Regulations for the Establishment of a Guidance Committee to Promote Business School Accreditation (hereinafter referred to as 'these Regulations' and 'the Committee' respectively) to actively strive for business school accreditation and strengthen the University's competitiveness in areas related to business and management.
- Article 2 The NPTU vice president for academic affairs shall serve as the Committee convener and the dean of the College of Management shall serve as vice-convener, while other members shall include the dean of academic affairs, the dean of international affairs, the dean of research and development, the dean of internship and career services, the director of the Office of Accounting, and the chairs of each department slated to undergo evaluation. In addition, the dean of the College shall appoint a associate dean to serve simultaneously as the Committee's executive director, and shall recommend several external experts to the University president, who, in turn, shall choose one of the external experts to serve as a member on the Committee. When necessary, the Committee may invite related personnel to attend its meetings.
- Article 3 The Committee's work tasks include the following:
 - 1. Review College strategies for promoting business school accreditation.
 - 2. Provide the College with consultation and advice regarding business school accreditation.
 - 3. Assist the College in handling matters related to business school accreditation.
- Article 4 The convener of the Committee shall convene and host all related meetings, while the executive director shall follow up on resolutions made during meetings and assess the progress of their implementation. In addition, the chairs of departments undergoing evaluation shall seek to carry out related duties and implement work tasks assigned to them in resolutions made by the Committee.
- Article 5 The Committee shall convene at least once per semester and unscheduled meetings may be called as per required.
- Article 6 The Committee's convener, vice-convener, executive director, and all its members serve in an unremunerated capacity. However, contingent on the workload involved, the dean may apply for approval from the University president to reduce the teaching hours of certain Committee members. Moreover, the Committee's external expert must be remunerated for attending Committee meetings and compensated for traffic expenses incurred in accordance with related University regulations.
- Article 7 These Regulations shall be published and implemented after being passed respectively in a college affairs meeting and an administrative meeting, and gaining the approval of the University president. The same applies to all amendments.
